## Suggested activities:

Choose 3 or more activity to do at home then bring in a photo of your work or the work itself to show the class.

Re-enact a fairy tale using props, puppets, masks or dress up. Can you say the repeated phrases in the story using voices of the characters?

Try cooking gingerbread men, make bread from the story of The Little Red Hen, taste porridge like Goldilocks-Talk about the change of materials from one state to another. Taste the fruits from The Very Hungry Caterpillar. How many food items can you count? Can you cut them in different shapes? Talk about the quantity and consistency of ingredients/ food items.
