Our learning this term

English

In English we will continue working on writing paragraphs using multiclaue compound sentences and multiclaue complex sentences joined with one subordinating conjunction and one co-ordinating conjunction. We will also focus on identifying and writing a combination of different sentence types to avoid repetition. We will be redrafting and improving our pieces of writing, adding simple sentences to enhance the mood and add emphasis. In the afternoon sessions, we will be working on improving our knowledge of grammar in preparation for SATs. Our reading book this term is 'The Giver' by Lois Lowry.

Maths

We will keep working on place value up to 1,000,000. We will also start working on word problems and reasoning questions in four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). In February we will start learning the foundations of algebra and then move on to fractions, decimals and percentages. In our afternoon Maths sessions the focus will be on revision and SATs preparation.

It is important for the children to keep learning their Times tables and corresponding division facts to ensure they have rapid recall of these.

Foundation

This term we will be learning about the history of our local area; learning the effects of World War II in the area. In Science, we will be learning more about the circulatory system, medicines and drugs, and keeping a healthy lifestyle. For PE, we will be learning a variety of Invasion games.
